Jessi Robinson helps lead Duke University to NCAA Tennis Championship

Sea Colony, Sussex County, Del., May 20, 2009 – Sea Colony Tennis Pro Dr. Dave Marshall congratulated Jessi Robinson, a Duke University senior, for leading the university to the NCAA Division 1 Women’s Tennis Championship. Jessi, a Sea Colony tennis instructor, and a student of the community’s program for 18 years, won her doubles match 8-5, and then won her singles match 6-2.

Jessi sent a text message to Dr. Dave shortly after helping her team win the NCAA tournament. He began coaching her at a junior academy in Sea Colony when she was 7 years old. “Once again, Jessi promised to play her heart out as she has done for years. This has been a journey, and we are very proud of her,” he said. Jessi began training at Sea Colony at the age of 4 under Dr. Dave Marshall, and joins the ranks of junior tennis players who became NCAA tennis stars in their colleges and universities. As testament to the success of its tennis programs, Sea Colony earned the rank of Gold Medal Resort by *TennisResortsOnline.com*, grading it No. 1 for Junior Programs, No. 4 for Children’s Programs, and No. 13 in the world.
